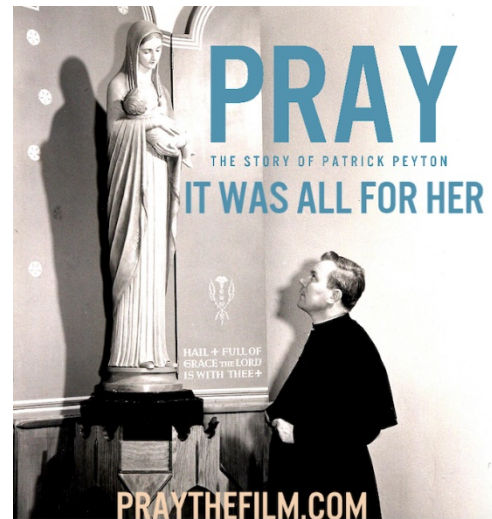
After much preparation, Catherine Lucy, director of Carondelet Consolidated Archive, passed the certification test and is now a member of the

## Report from last week's CLG meeting

The Congregational Leadership Group held a fruitful meeting from September 17-21. Though we missed the opportunity to see each other in person, we were able to achieve our meeting goals via Zoom and even built in some fun times together. Beautiful daily prayers focused on our meeting theme "going deeper." For our weekend liturgy, we celebrated a house church eucharist together.

Using film and discussion, we reflected on cultural diversity and considered the danger of knowing only a "single story" about another culture which leads to stereotypes. We looked at the results of our congregational survey about the chapter directions. Energy filled us as both the CLT and the vice/provinces shared the many ways in which we are responding to these directions.

Each vice/province outlined their plan for the governance discernment process now that the original design had to be modified in the face of COVID-19. While the timelines now allow almost a year's difference before some units complete their discernment, we are comfortable with this diversity.

We previewed the anticipated intra-congregational gatherings. While we recognize that this year's offerings must take place online, we hope that at least some of those planned starting next summer can occur in person.

Now that the Congregational Novitiate has completed 2.5 years of operation, a group, in consultation with novitiate participants, leaders, formators, local communities, and other stakeholders, will evaluate the experience. The CLG also manifested support for common vocation promotion efforts.

Kim Westerman, congregational director of communications, joined us to review the various communications that we as a congregation publish either online or in hard copy. We agreed to consider how we might use the power and resources of our communications more effectively and efficiently.
